Experience:

- Previous experience in a similar role, ideally involving building or grounds maintenance.
- Experience using basic maintenance tools and equipment.

- Understanding of health and safety regulations, especially in relation to handling hazardous substances and safer handling guidelines.
- Ability to use hand tools, small power tools, and electrical cleaning equipment.
- Knowledge of operating alarm and security systems.

- Excellent communication skills and the ability to work well with school staff, contractors, and pupils.
- Highly organised with the ability to multitask and prioritise tasks in a busy environment.
- Self-motivated, able to work independently and use initiative.
- A proactive approach to problem-solving.
- Be aware of and support equal opportunities for all.
- To be a proactive member of the school team, contributing to the overall ethos / work / aims of the school.
- Participate in training and other learning activities and performance development as required.
- Recognise own strengths and areas of expertise and use these to advise and support others.
