Key Role/Function:

To provide high standards of cleanliness throughout the school – working individually as well as part of a team.

Specific Duties

Cleaning

- Be responsible for ensuring the cleanliness of your designated areas and for maintaining high and consistent standards
- Take initiative to perform cleaning and tidying tasks that are not specifically contained within the rota but require attention as part of maintaining overall high standards.
- Liaise with the Site Manager and Housekeeper and other members of staff as required to ensure the cleaning rota operates smoothly.
- Report cleaning supplies requirements and stock levels to the Housekeeper.
- Ensure Health & Safety, quality and general procedure compliance.
- Work as part of a team to meet standards and school objectives, report any Health and Safety issues to the Site Manager and Housekeeper.
- Report any obvious defects such as blocked toilets, broken fixtures and fittings etc to the Housekeeper during the completion of his/her duties.
