The successful candidates will have the skills to meet the diverse needs of pupils within the school who have severe or profound and multiple learning difficulties, and may also have Autistic Spectrum Conditions, physical or sensory impairments. A number of the pupils at Foxfield also demonstrate complex and challenging behaviours. Additional training and support is provided for staff to enable them to meet the needs of such pupils.
